AUTOTEST TRAINING DAY – SUNDAY 23rd MAY 2010

1. The Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club Ltd. will organise a Clubsport status Autotest Training Day to be held at Headcorn Aerodrome, Kent. (MR 188/848829) on Sunday 23rd May 2010.

The purpose of the meeting is to provide newcomers to the sport an opportunity to learn what is involved in autotesting and to have a chance of trying the sport without the added pressure of competition. Experts will be on hand to answer your questions and give guidance with regard to test procedures, car preparation, driving techniques, etc.

- 2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Limited (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3. The practice session will be run under dual Permits issued by the MSA, as follows:-

Class A Clubsport Autotest Permit No: **TBA** Class B Clubsport Production Car Autotest Permit No: **TBA**

- 4. The practice session will be open to all fully elected members of the organising club and the following invited clubs: Weald Motor Club, the HRCR and Rochester Motor Club; membership cards will be inspected at signing on.
- 5. The programme of the meeting will be as follows:

15.30 Meeting Closes

6. The Practice Session will consist of two groups, as follows:

> Class A For drivers aged 17 and over who hold a full RTA Licence – for all classes of car

Class B For drivers aged 14 to 17, or over, who do not hold a full RTA Licence. All

> vehicles completing in this class must be by definition a Touring Car". Whilst competing, **one passenger must be carried** in each car, who holds a full RTA Licence, is a full member of M&MKMC and is experienced in Autotesting. **NOTE**: It is also permitted for the passenger and driver to swap roles in order to give further tuition, provided an additional entry, as

appropriate, is completed.

All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations and be fitted with road pattern tyres only. Any vehicle fitted with tyres which the organisers deem unsuitable will not be allowed to compete. THIS MEANS NO KNOBBLIES!

- 7. As the event is intended as a practice day, there will be no results produced or issued, and there will be no awards.
- Entry for the Practice Session opens on publication of these regulations and closes finally at 14.00 8. hrs on the day of the event. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee as follows:

Class A £10.00 (£12.00 for non MMKMC members) £ 5.00 Class B (£6.00 for non MMKMC members)

Note: Reduced price membership to MMKMC (£7.00) is available to Junior Drivers aged 14 to 17 in Class B.

SPECIAL OFFER – Any <u>new</u> members joining M&MKMC and entering the event at the same time will be allowed free entry to one of the evening autotests in the 2010 series.

The maximum entry for the practice session is 30, the minimum for each group is 1. Should the minimum entry not be reached, the field be too wet or the field not be available, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting.

- 11. Details of tests will be issued on the day. Each driver will be able to have a number of runs at all, or any of the tests set out. Not all the tests will necessarily be timed, and any timing will only be done so that drivers may assess their own improvement and to assist with marshals training.
- 12. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with the MSA Competitors. Breach of Regulations (C.d).
- 13. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written, except the following which are modified:
 - D.41 As the whole event takes place on private property, vehicles need not be licensed.
 - D.28 Marking and Penalties will be as printed in Table 1, except where amended as follows for all classes:
 - (c) "Not performing a test correctly, etc." +30 seconds
 - (d) "Striking any pylon, etc., per mistake" +10 seconds
 - (e) "Failing to cross or stop at any line, etc." +10 seconds
 - (g) "Every second (& fraction) to complete test" 1 & fraction
