# KENT DRIVER AUTOTEST

- 1. The Maidstone and Mid Kent Motor Club Limited will promote a National 'B' permit Autotest on **Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2012** at **Central Park Stadium**, Sittingbourne, Kent, by kind permission of 'Sittingbourne Greyhounds'.
- 2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Limited (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3. The event will be run under a Permit issued by the MSA which will be on display on the day. **Permit No.:- 70785**
- 4. The event is open to :
  - a) all fully elected members of the promoting club;
  - b) all registered competitors in the following 2012 championships:
    - 'Link-Up Ltd' MSA British Autotest Championship;
    - 'demon tweeks Direct' BTRDA Autotest Championship;
    - Southern Autotest Championship;
    - BTRDA Allrounders championship, supported by REIS;
  - c) fully elected members of clubs affiliated to the following associations:
    - ASEMC; ACSMC; ECAMC.
- 5. The event is a round of the following championships:

'Link-Up Ltd' MSA British Autotest - Reg. No. 2012/A/0700

'demon tweeks *Direct*' BTRDA Autotest

Southern Autotest - Reg. No. 49/2012 BTRDA Allrounders - Reg. No. 008/2012

- 6. All drivers must produce for inspection at signing-on a valid Competition Licence and Club Membership Card. Where appropriate, Championship Registration Cards and Entrants Licences must also be produced for inspection.
- 7. The programme of the meeting will be:

Scrutineering starts at 10.00 am

Any Competitors not signed on by 12.00 noon may be excluded.

First car starts at 12.00 hrs. Mid Day

The event will consist of 5 classes as follows:

- A. Sallon Cars under 11' overall length.
- **B.** All other Saloon Cars.
- **C.** Sports Cars and Sports Kit Cars.
- **D.** Specials.
- E. Roadgoing Saloon Cars.

#### Note:

All vehicles in class E will be capable of being driven on the road, be taxed and have a current MoT test certificate (if applicable), which will be checked at signing on.

Cabriolet Saloon Cars must run in appropriate Saloon Car class with the hood up, or in the appropriate sports car class with the hood down.

Sports kit cars eligible for classes C and Saloon kit cars eligible for classes A, B & E, will be as per the approved BTRDA Championship list which is available from the Championship Secretary.

Vehicle length is to be determined from Parkers Car Price Guide for the car concerned, or if not quoted, the manufacturers specification.

All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations.

9. Awards will be presented as follows:

FTD The Harold Sharp Trophy\* & Replica

Best Performance by a full The Haynes Brothers member of the Maidstone & Challenge Trophy\*

Mid Kent Motor Club & Replica First in Class An Award

Second in Class An Award (subject to 5 or more starters)

Third in Class An Award (subject to 10 or more starters)

Best Novice An Award
Best Lady An Award

(\* These awards are to be held for 11 months only)

No competitor may win more than one award, other than the Haynes Brothers Challenge Trophy

- 10. The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes finally on **FRIDAY** <sup>1st</sup> **June 2012**. The entry fee is £32.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.
- 11. M.11. Entries will be accepted from drivers who are 16, 17 or over without a current full RTA licence provided the vehicle they are entering is a touring car of no more than 1400cc. (M.11.1.2)

- 13. The maximum entry for the meeting is 50 including 5 reserves. The minimum is 25. The maximum for each class is unlimited. The minimum for each class is 1. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected as received.
- 14. Other officials are:

- 15. Provisional results will be published, and awards presented, as soon as possible following the end of the event.
- 16. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with the MSA Yearbook, section (C.5.1) Protests.
- 17. Details of tests will be available on the day of the event. Each driver will have a number of runs at each test, all runs to count for results.

Timing will be by hand held watches, timed to 0.1 seconds.

The starting signal will be oral.

Order of attempting the tests will be strictly as directed at the drivers briefing.

18. M.26. All marshals will be appointed as judges to adjudicate on penalties.

- 19. Practising will **NOT** be allowed, any competitor, in the opinion of the organisers, speeding, or performing handbrake turns or the like, in the paddock or surrounding area may be **excluded.**
- 20. Competitors will be identified by numbers, which will be provided by the organisers.
- 21. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written except for the following which are modified
- 22. M.27.4. Marking and Penalties

Marking and penalties will be as printed in Table M.7. except where amended as follows:

- (c) "Not performing a test correctly, etc" +20 seconds
- (d) "Striking any marker, etc per mistake" + 5 seconds
- (e) "Failing to cross or stop at any line, etc" + 5 seconds

Wrong Tests M.23. is replaced by the following:

A test shall be deemed to have been performed correctly providing that before the car crosses the finish line all mandatory manoeuvres, including lines, as shown on the diagram have been performed or crossed in the correct order and direction as required by the diagram, regardless of any additional manoeuvres or lines that may have been included or crossed at any time.

- 23. H.35.1.4. A novice will be defined as a driver who has not previously won a class or overall award in an Autotest or similar competition of National 'B', equivalent or higher status.
- 24. M.4.2. Pylons may be less than 1 metre in height.
- 25. M.17.1. As the whole event takes place on private property vehicles in Classes A D need not be licenced.
- 26. M.13.4. A vehicle may be entered twice to be driven by different drivers but no driver may drive more than one vehicle.
- 27. H.31.1.1.2e. Entry fees will only be refunded if notice of withdrawal is given in writing. Where notice of withdrawal is received <u>before 1st June 2012</u> entry fees will be refunded in full, after that date refunds, up to a maximum of £15, will be made at the discretion of the organisers.
- 28. Please make sure your car is properly silenced to comply with M.16.3.
