SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Weald Motor Club Limited will promote a Clubmans Production Car Trial, organised by the Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club Ltd on Sunday 1st April 2012 at Stoneacre Farm, Otham, Kent. The event will be open to all fully elected members of the organising club, the HRCR, six invited clubs and all registered contenders of the 2012 ASEMC and ACSMC Trials Championship.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of The Motor Sports Association Limited (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the Clubs may issue for the Event.
3. The MSA Clubmans Permit No 69869
4. Club membership cards and/or competition licenses will be inspected at Signing-on. For those drivers competing in the ASEMC Trials Championship, their passengers need to be a fully paid up member of an ASEMC Member Club.
5. The event will take place at map reference 188 / 800536. The event will take place entirely on Private Land. There will be at least 5 tests and it is hoped that at least two runs will be allowed at each test. Signing-on will commence at 09:00 hours, followed immediately by Scrutineering. The Event will start at 10.30 hours. Any competitor who has not signed on by 10.30 hours may be excluded. Each competing car must run with at least one passenger and the passenger(s) must also be signed-on for that competing car.
6. All cars will comply with the 2012 MSA Vehicle and Tyre Regulations. The following classes will apply:
 1. Two Wheel Drive Production Cars first registered on or after 1st January 1998, taxed for road use, carrying no ballast, no modifications and driven to the venue. The original carburetors or fuel injection system including the throttle body and plenum chamber, including the air filter system must be retained. It is permitted to replace the air filter element within the original housing. It is permitted to fit a sump guard weighing no more than 10kg.
 2. Front Wheel Drive Production Cars not eligible for Class 1.
 3. Rear Wheel Drive Production Cars not eligible for Class 1.
 4. Modified Production Car and Kit Cars.
 5. Two Wheel Drive Rally Cars not using a limited slip differential as described in the 2011 MSA Competitors Yearbook, Sections R18 to R18.6.4 for Road Rallying.
 6. Two Wheel Drive Rally Cars using a limited slip differential.

Classes 5&6 may not be included in the index of performance for overall winner for those entered in the ASEM Championship.

7. Vehicles will be strictly scrutineered. Classification of any vehicle will be entirely at the discretion of the organisers.
8. Awards will be presented as follows:
First Overall (least total of penalties).
First in each Class.
Second in each Class, subject to five entries
Third in each class, subject to eight entries
Classes with less than two entries may be amalgamated at the organisers discretion.
(No Competitor may win more than one award)
9. The entry list opens on publication of these Supplementary Regulations and closes on **Monday 26th march 2012**. All entries must be made on the official entry form and be accompanied by the appropriate fee.
The entry fee is **£18.00**. Entry fees may be refunded at the organisers' discretion. Late entries may be accepted at the organisers discretion and be subject to a fee of **£25.00**.

12. The maximum number of entries for this event is 40 the minimum is 15. There is no maximum or minimum class entry. Should the minimum entry figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the meeting. A maximum of two (at the organiser's discretion) drivers per car will be accepted, each being treated as a separate entry. Final instructions will be made available to entrants before the start of the competition.
13. We bring your attention MSA GR T4.1 – 4.1.11 and **remind you that no front passenger may be under the age of 12 years** and that the Passenger(s) comprising the crew at the start **must not be altered during the competition**.
14. Starting order will be in accordance with MSA GR T5.2.
15. Penalties will be as MSA GR T7.5 as printed.
16. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of the event. Protests must be made in accordance with MSA GR C5.2.
17. Identification numbers will be supplied by the organisers and must be fixed in a prominent forward facing position.
18. All marshals are appointed "Judges of Fact" to adjudicate on items listed under GR T7.1 - 5.
19. As the event takes place on private property, apart from Class 1, cars need not be currently registered, taxed and MOT'ed, but they must be properly silenced.
