EVENING AUTOTEST SERIES 2014

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. The Maidstone & Mid Kent Motor Club Limited will organise a Clubsport status Grass Autotest series at Headcorn Aerodrome, Kent. (MR 188/848829) on the following **Wednesdays in 2013**:-

April: 30th May: 7th & 21st June: 4th & 18th July: 2nd, 16th & 30th, August: 20th

- 2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Limited (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.
- 3. Each event will be run under dual Permits issued by the MSA, as follows:-

Classes A to E Clubmans, Autotest Permit

Class J Clubmans, Production Car Autotest Permit

Which will be on display at the corresponding event.

- 4. The events are open to all fully elected members of the organising club, and the following invited clubs:- Weald Motor Club, and the Historic Rally Car Register
- 5. All competitors must produce for inspection at signing-on, a valid Club Membership Card for the event.
- 6. The programme of the meeting for each event will be as follows:-
 - Scrutineering starts at 6.15 p.m.
 - Any competitor not signed on by 7.30 p.m. may be excluded
 - Each event will start at 6.30 p.m.
 - The closing time of tests will be notified at each event.
- 7. Each event will consist of six classes as follows:
 - A. Front wheel drive Touring Cars up to and including 3.66m (12ft) overall length
 - B. Front wheel drive Touring Cars over 3.66m (12ft) and under 4.1m (13' 5³/₄") overall length
 - C. Front wheel drive Touring Cars 4.1m (13'-5¾") and over, and Four-wheel drive Series Production Touring cars.
 - D. Rear wheel drive Touring Cars and all Sports Cars.
 - E. Specials.
 - J. Production Car Autotest, for *Junior Drivers*. Aged 14 to 17 who do not hold a full RTA Licence. (See below for Supplementary Regulations.)

All vehicles competing in this class must be by definition "a Touring Car". Whilst competing, one passenger must be carried in each car, who holds a full RTA Licence is a full member of one of the above named clubs and is experienced in Autotesting.

NOTE: It is also permitted for the passenger and driver to swap roles, in order to give further tuition, provided an additional entry, as appropriate, is completed. However, only the *Junior Drivers*' times will count towards any award. It is not permissible for the passenger to make a separate entry as a driver

All vehicle lengths will be taken as stated in the "Parkers Car Price Guide" or, if not quoted, the manufacturers specification.

8. All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations, and be fitted with road pattern tyres only. Any vehicle fitted with tyres which the organisers deem unsuitable will not be allowed to complete.

9. Awards will be presented at each event as follows:-

FTD An award First in each class An award

Second in each class

An award (subject to 5 or more starters)

Third in each class

An award (subject to 10 or more starters)

Best Novice An award

Other awards may be given at the organiser's discretion.

No competitor may win more than one award.

- 10. Competitors will be identified by numbered time cards, which will be issued by the organisers.
- 11. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes finally, for each event, at 7.30 p.m. on the day of the event. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee as follows:-

Classes A-E £13.00

Class J £ 7.00 for each competitor.

Note: Reduced price membership to MMKMC (at £7.00) is available to *Junior Drivers* in class J.

The maximum entry for each event is 40, and the minimum is 10. The maximum for each class is unlimited, and the minimum is 1. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the field be too wet or the field not be available, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary. Entries will be selected in order of receipt. Entry fees may be refunded if notification of withdrawal is given to the Secretary of the Meeting not less than 24 hours before the event.

- 13. Other officials are: Club Stewards - Lyle Cathcart/Bruce Jenkins/Mike Jordan
- 14. Details of tests for each event will be issued at signing on. Each driver will have two runs at each test, with only the drivers best run at each test to count towards results. Timing for all classes will be by hand held watches, timed to 0.1 seconds (M.15). The starting signal will be oral. Order of attempting tests will be as directed by the organisers. Practising will not be allowed. All marshals will be judges to adjudicate on penalties (M.8).
- 15. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible following the end of each event.
- 16. Any protests must be lodged in accordance with MSA Yearbook – Judicial (C) – Protests.
- 17. All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written except the following which are modified:-
 - (H) 35.1.4 A Novice is defined as a driver who prior to 01-01-2013 has not won an award, other than Best Novice at an Autotest.
 - (M) 13.4 For each event, a vehicle may not be entered to compete for the same award more than twice, to be driven by different drivers, but no driver may enter more than once. The number of drivers for any one vehicle is limited to three
 - As the whole event takes place on private property vehicles need not be licenced (M) 17.1
 - (M) 17.2 Light commercial vehicles are accepted and will be treated as Touring Cars
 - (M) 27.4Marking and Penalties will be as printed in Table M.7 except where amended as follows for all classes:-
 - (c) "Not performing a test correctly, etc." +30 seconds
 - (d) "Striking any pylon, etc. per mistake" +10 seconds
 - "Failing to cross or stop at any line etc." +10 seconds (e)
 - "Every second (& fraction) to complete test (f) 1 & fraction

CLASS J, for JUNIOR DRIVERS.

SUPPLIMENTARY REGULATIONS

Our successful **Class J** for "**Junior Drivers**", will be run under MSA specific regulations for a **Production Car Autotest** as follows:-

- 1. All *Junior Drivers* must be 14, 15, 16, or 17 and not hold a full RTA Driving Licence.
- 2. **AT ALL TIMES** each *Junior Driver* must carry **one passenger** in the car, who may assist in giving directions to the driver, holds a full RTA Driving Licence and is experienced in autotesting
- 3. It is permitted for the passenger and Junior Driver to swap roles, in order to give further tuition, provided an additional entry, as appropriate, is completed. However, only the Junior Drivers times will count towards any award.
- 4. Both Driver and Passenger must be a member of Maidstone and Mid Kent Motor Club or one of the invited clubs, and sign on as appropriate.
- 5. The passenger must occupy the seat alongside the driver and **wear a properly fastened approved seat belt** at all times during the test.
- 6. All vehicles in this Class must be by definition a **touring car.** They do not have to be driven to the event, however, they must comply with MSA Vehicle Regulations and pass scrutineering at the event. This definition means that sports cars and cabriolet vehicles cannot be used.
- 7. The tests will be the same as the main event, and only a drivers best time at each test will count towards results.
 - Tests will be timed to 1/10 second
 - Penalty for touching a course marker 10 seconds
 - Penalty for a wrong test 30 seconds plus the fastest time in Class J for that test.

of car.

Class B For drivers aged 14 to 17, or over, who do not hold a full RTA Licence. All

vehicles completing in this class must be by definition a Touring Car". Whilst competing, one passenger must be carried in each car, who holds a full RTA Licence, is a full member of M&MKMC and is experienced in Autotesting. NOTE: It is also permitted for the passenger and driver to swap roles in order to give further tuition, provided an additional entry, as

appropriate, is completed.

All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations and be fitted with road pattern tyres only. Any vehicle fitted with tyres which the organisers deem unsuitable will not be allowed to compete. **THIS MEANS NO KNOBBLIES!**

7. As the event is intended as a practice day, there will be no results produced or issued, and there will be no awards.
